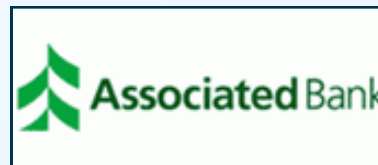

Housing Improvement Program (HIP)

Types of Projects*

- Front Step repairs
- Repainting homes or garages
- Removal of lawn debris
- Demolition of failing structures
- Other Small exterior renovations

* Typical projects cost \$500-1,000, but there is no formal limit

Eligibility Requirements

- Located in the City of Ashland
- Single Family Homes
(no duplexes or multi-family)
- Owner-occupied (no rentals)
- Property taxes up to date
