

CHAPTER 210. UNLAWFUL SHELTERING OF MINORS.

210.01 Unlawful Sheltering of Minors.

(a) No person owning, operating or controlling any premises shall by any means conceal or shelter or assist in the concealing or sheltering of any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years on or in the said premises while the minor is under the legal custody of the parents or legal guardian and while the minor is on report to any law enforcement agency as a missing person, a runaway, or a wanted person.

(b) The person owning, operating or in custody of the premises shall not be liable under the foregoing paragraph if the owner, operator or custodian of the said premises has:

(1) Obtained the permission of the parents or legal guardian, or

(2) Notified the City of Ashland Police Department of the presence of the said minor.

210.02. Alcoholic Beverages. No person shall, by any means, permit or assist an underage person to consume any malt beverage or intoxicating liquor.

210.03 False Information. No person shall supply false information to or obstruct any Police Officer in the performance of his duty to locate or take into custody any minor described in section 210.01(a).

210.04 Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 together with the cost of prosecution.
