

## **CHAPTER 353. NUISANCE DEER HUNT.**

**353.01. Permitting Nuisance Deer Hunt.** Due to the nuisance deer problem in the City of Ashland, there shall be permitted in the City of Ashland Archery Deer Hunting in the City of Ashland subject to the following conditions:

(a) Conduction. The Nuisance Deer Hunt shall be conducted during the regular Wisconsin Deer Archery season with all archery regulations applying to the Nuisance Deer Hunt.

(b) Obtaining Permit. The Archery Hunter shall obtain a Nuisance Deer Permit from the Ashland Police Department.

(c) Land Owners. The land owner upon whose property the Nuisance Deer Hunting is to be done shall obtain a Designation of Permitted Area for Shooting Arrows in the City of Ashland Permit from the Ashland Police Department.

(d) Compliance. The land owner and archery hunter shall comply with all rules and regulations adopted by the Common Council for the Nuisance Deer Hunt.

**353.02. Enforcement.** Violation of any of the foregoing shall be a violation of this Ordinance which is punishable by a forfeiture not less than \$100.00 and no more than \$500.00, plus court costs. The Ashland Police Department will enforce the provisions of this Ordinance to the use of forfeiture citations.

**353.03. Establishment of Rules.** The Common Council of the City of Ashland shall by Resolution establish rules and regulations for the Nuisance Deer Permit Hunt in the Ashland City limits.
