AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF THE CITY STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

The Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Ashland do ordain as follows:

502.01

No person shall have any exclusive right to any location in the public streets or on the public sidewalks, nor shall any person be permitted to obstruct any sidewalks nor to have a stationary location upon any public streets, nor shall any vehicle be permitted to operate in a congested area in a manner where such operation might impede or inconvenience the public use of such streets. For the purpose of this ordinance, the judgement of a police officer exercised in good faith, shall be deemed conclusive as to whether the area is congested and the public impeded and inconvenienced.

502.02

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a forfeiture of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and the cost of prosecution, and in default or payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be confined to the county jail until payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, but not exceeding thirty (30) days for each violation.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
