

How can we make recycling better together?

Recyclable

These items can **always** be placed in your recycling cart:



PLASTICS

Recycle plastics #1 and #2. Look on the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.



METAL CANS, ALUMINUM FOIL AND ALUMINUM FOIL PANS

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans – steel, tin, bimetal and aluminum.



CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINES

Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



PAPER CONTAINERS AND CARTONS

Recycle food boxes including juice boxes, ice cream and paper milk containers, and cereal and pasta boxes (remove inside bags).



PAPER

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.

Recycling Simplified

Simple as 1-2-3

1. Know what to throw

Cardboard, paper, metal cans, plastic bottles and jugs.



2. Empty. Clean. Dry.

Keep all recyclables free of food and liquid.



3. Keep it loose

Never put recyclables in containers or bags.



Please do not bag recyclables!

Do Not Recycle

These items can **never** be placed in your recycling cart:

- Plastic bags
- Plastic straws
- Plastic food wrappers
- Plastic without numbers
- Greasy food containers
- Food or liquid waste
- Yard waste
- Construction debris
- Scrap metal
- Hazardous waste
- Electronics
- Cables or batteries
- Diapers
- Tissue
- Biohazardous waste
- Light bulbs
- Ceramics
- Dishes or mirrors
- Hoses
- Toys
- Clothes
- Shoes
- Tools
- Polystyrene foam
- To-go lids
- Holiday decorations
- Hardback books
- Egg cartons
- Ice cream cartons (wax-coated)

Accepted Materials

Ensure items are Empty. Clean. Dry.



Paper & Cardboard

Cardboard (flattened), office paper, file folders, magazines, catalogs, newspaper and inserts, junk mail, telephone books, etc.



Aluminum/Metal

Aluminum, tin or steel cans, pie tins



Plastic

Plastic bottles, containers



Glass

Glass jars, bottles

Do not put your recyclables inside plastic bags

Unacceptable Recycling Items

- Plastic grocery bags
- Food waste
- Yard waste
- Light bulbs, window glass or mirrors
- Batteries
- Ceramics or dishes
- Cellphones, computers or electronics
- Clothing
- Polystyrene foam (*Styrofoam®)
- Hazardous waste containers
- Garden hoses
- Construction waste
- Oil containers of any kind
