Living Memorials—Trees and Perennial Plants

The MEMORIAL TREE PROGRAM is established to promote the planting of trees in City Parks and other public property as a living memorial for: Honoring the memory of a deceased relative, friend, or leader; Commemorating a special day or event; Acknowledging the birth of a child; Gift tree for a special occasion

GENERAL INFORMATION

The City will provide and plant a tree at an approved planting site on City Owned Property. The size of the tree is a minimum 1-1/2" diameter. Trees are only planted during the spring and fall. The City of Ashland will keep accurate records of all trees planted

COST

The minimum cost to participate in this program is \$350, cost includes the tree, planting, staking, memorial plaque (8"X10") and care until the tree is established. The City will guarantee the tree for a period of one year from the date planted. If the tree dies due to stress or disease during the guarantee period the City will replace the tree at no cost. The guarantee only applies to loss due to disease and planting related causes.
