

# WINTER SNOW REMOVAL 2025-2026



## CITY PLOWING

In the event of a snowfall of 4" or more, please be aware that emergency routes will always be plowed first, followed by the streets and avenues, with alleys being cleared last. In order to clear the streets for travel the City of Ashland Public Works crew uses side plow wings which deposit snow along the curb or in the grass boulevard on the city right of way. This unfortunately ends up leaving snow in driveway entrances for residents to clear themselves.

## PARKING NOVEMBER 1st to APRIL 1st

### **NO PARKING:**

- Between 2:00am - 6:00am in the Downtown Area; Lake Shore Dr, Main St and 3rd St from Beaser Ave to Stuntz Ave.
- From 12:00 am-6:00 am on any residential street or avenue in the City of Ashland.

### **Daytime Parking from 6:00am-12:00am:**

- Park on even numbered side of street/avenue on even numbered calendar days.
- Park on odd numbered side of street/avenue on odd numbered calendar days.

### **During Winter Emergencies:**

NO street or avenue parking day or night during snow emergencies.

## Snow Removals

- ◆ Removal of sidewalk snow is responsibility of the property owner.
- ◆ Remove to the lowest level possible to allow safe travel by pedestrians.
- ◆ Remove within 48 hrs after a measurable snowfall or after the declared end of a snow emergency.
- ◆ Failure to remove snow and ice from sidewalk can result in a fine or a forfeiture levied against the property.
- ◆ Please help us in ensuring fire hydrants are also kept shoveled out.

## **GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION**



- **Have your containers out before 6:00 AM on collection day. In the event of a snow emergency, collection may be delayed to allow crews to clear snow.**
- **Containers should be at least 3 feet from carts, telephone poles, vehicles, etc. to allow the automated arm to pick up. Collection cannot occur if the containers are on top of snow banks.**
- **Shovel snow to keep an area open for containers, this allows plows to come by without damaging the containers**
- **Garbage and Recycling will be picked up on all holidays with the exception of Christmas Day.**
